### VICTOR CAYRES DE MENDONCA



Victor Cayres is a student of Anthony diBonaventura and was chosen as a finalist in the most recent BU School of Music's annual Soloists Competition. He has appeared with Keith Lockhart and the Boston Pops as well as a soloist with the Brazilian Symphony Orchestra, the University of Sao Paulo Symphony, the NEC Philharmonic and the Orchestre des Jeunes, amongst others. Although he began studying piano at a relatively late age, Cayres has won accolades for his performances throughout Europe, the US and Brazil, his home country.

### PHUONG NGHI PHAM



Phuong Nghi Pham, now 16, began piano lessons at the age of five in Vietnam, where she won many prizes in competitions, including First Prize in the Yamaha Cup in 2004.

A student of the New England Conservatory Preparatory School since September 2006, she was the first recipient of the John C. Holtz Ambassador Award from the concert's co-sponsor, The Max Reger Foundation of America, a nonprofit organization that helps musicians fulfill their dreams and goals.

This Steinway is a New York Grand Model B, Ebonized, 7 1/4 octave (88 notes), 6'10" Grand Piano. Completed on May 29, 1911 it was delivered to a dealer Edmund Gram Music Company of Milwaukee, Wisconsin on June 8, 1911.
